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The West Virginia Governmental Ethics Act defines: [WV Code 6B-1-3]

(d) **Immediate Family** - a spouse residing in the individual's household and any dependent child or children and dependent parent or parents.

(h) **Public Employee** - means any full-time or part-time employee of any governmental body or any political subdivision thereof, including county school boards.

(i) **Public Official** – any person who is elected or appointed and who is responsible for the making of policy or takes official action with respect to (i) contracting or procurement of goods or services; (ii) administering or monitoring grants or subsidies; (iii) planning or zoning; (iv) inspecting, licensing, regulating or auditing any person; (v) any other activity where the official action has an economic impact of greater than a de minimis nature on the interest or interests of any person.
